Unrated Students: 6 Hours first season as a student; 14 Hours each unrated season thereafter

Level 1 Members: 14 Hours

* Single members pay \$75 membership fee. "Household Membership" is 2 adults & minor children (under 21) living at the same residence & membership charge is \$110 for two members using "Household Membership." Total cost for one (Single Membership) class fee is \$353. If two (same household) members are enrolling for classes, the charge is \$666 (\$110 membership fee, \$246 sail pass fee, and \$310 tuition = \$666).
